

# COVID-19 Vaccination in Øygarden Municipality







Everyone over the age of 18, who is a citizen or staying in Øygarden Municipality over time, shall be offered a COVID-19 vaccine.

# COVID-19 vaccine in Øygarden

The purpose of vaccination against COVID-19 is to protect the life and health of those who are most vulnerable to disease from the coronavirus. The vaccine protects each individual person from disease. Once a sufficient portion of the population has been vaccinated, spread of the disease may be prevented. For companies, vaccination is important to help ensure a stable workforce.



Everyone over the age of 18, who is a citizen or staying in Øygarden Municipality over time, shall be offered a COVID-19 vaccine.

Persons from other municipalities, who commute to Øygarden to work or study, shall in general get vaccinated in Bergen.

Initially there will not be enough COVID-19 vaccines for everyone and the most vulnerable will be vaccinated first. The Norwegian Institute of Public Health distributes vaccines and the Municipality of Øygarden will give vaccines as soon as doses become available.



Citizens and those staying in the municipality in connection with work and studying can register in the vaccination queue electronically. To do this, it is necessary to have a personal identification number or D-number.

# How to register electronically

- 1. Click on the following link: vaksine. oygarden.kommune.no
- 2. Sign in with BankID.
- 3. Choose the option for registering for yourself or on behalf of others.
- 4. Answer simple questions regarding age, occupation and health.
- 5. Submit.
- 6. You will receive a text message confirming registration.
- 7. You will later receive a text message informing you that it is time to book an appointment.
- 8. Click the link to book an appointment.
- 9. Book an appointment for both dose one and dose two. You are responsible for ensuring that you get the second dose as well.
- 10. The booking will be confirmed via a text message.
- 11. Turn up at the location where you were given a vaccination appointment at the agreed time and date.
